STRONGER TOGETHER...

I read in one of Pastor David Jeremiah's recent *Turning Point* devotions of how San Francisco's Golden Gate Bridge is supported (04/16/2024). The roadway of the bridge is suspended from two massive cables. Each of the two cables is three feet in diameter. Each cable consists of 61 bundles of steel wire, each bundle containing 452 wires, bringing the total number of steel wires in each cable to 27,572. To the observing eye, it appears that the roadway is suspended from two large cables but in reality, it is suspended from 55,144 tiny wires bundled together.

The Qoheleth of Ecclesiastes said, "Two are better than one...and a threefold cord is not quickly broken" (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12). As you know, there is strength in numbers. The Apostle Paul used the analogy of the human body to illustrate the effectiveness of the Body of Christ (I Corinthians 12). Each part of the human body is like an individual in the church. The faithfulness of one member is multiplied exponentially when combined with the faith of all. Whether one wire in a cable, one part of a physical body, or one believer in the Church, all are essentially important to unity, strength, and effectiveness.

The writer of Hebrews said that we are "to consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together..." (Hebrews 10:24-25). Be encouraged to be an active part in strengthening the Body of Christ by meeting regularly and joyfully serving with others in the kingdom work of Christ. There is no insignificant member in a church. We are stronger together.
